About the Scholarship

The Fraser Stryker Diversity Scholarship provides financial aid to Black, Indigenous, and People of Color (BIPOC) college-bound students in the Omaha metro area who are interested in pursuing a career in law and have a financial need. Scholarship recipients will also have the opportunity to work a paid internship at Fraser Stryker during the summer to further their knowledge in the legal field.

Scholarship Details

Recipients are awarded \$2,500 per academic school year up to four years. The scholarship applies to tuition, fees, books, and supplies needed for the recipient's college program. Scholarships are subject to yearly renewal at the discretion of Fraser Stryker's Scholarship Committee. Maintaining a minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA and 12 credit hours per semester is required.

Eligibility Criteria

Eligible applicants must meet the following minimum requirements at the time of application:

- High school senior who is of one of the following minority groups: Black/African American, American Indian or Alaska Native, Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander, Asian, Hispanic, or Middle Eastern/North African
- Accepted to an accredited college or university located in the U.S.
- Interested in pursuing a career in the legal field
- Ability to demonstrate a financial need
- In the top 20% class rank
